The second week is our Law Enforcement Program, while the third week will center on Biology. ## Engineering Camp

July 18 – July 22, 2011

Engineering Camp will allow students to interact with actual Biomedical, Electrical, Software and Mechanical engineers who create the Welch Allyn products and designs. Students will explore how these disciplines contribute to making innovative, world class medical devices. At Lockheed Martin, they will participate in teams to solve a series of hands-on engineering challenges that will test your problem solving and design skills. Visits with DEC biologists locally are also in the plan for Biology Camp. Discover the many different careers available and gain important insight into a possible career in the biology field.
