



## Hiawatha Seaway Council 2010 National Jamboree Refund Policy

- Regardless of the date, as long as there is a Scout who is an acceptable replacement and that replacement is paid up according to the council payment schedule, there will be a full refund less the national registration fee.
- Generally, there will be no refund of any money that has been expended on behalf of a jamboree participant unless an acceptable replacement is available and paid up according to the council payment schedule. These expenditures include, but are not limited to: national jamboree payments, transportation fees, hotel accommodations, special event tickets, equipment purchases, jamboree patches.
- Exemptions can be considered to allow for partial and full refunds considering hardship circumstances. These circumstances include unforeseen medical problems and a death in the immediate family. Summer school is not a hardship circumstance.
- Refund requests will be considered when a parent or guardian of the jamboree participant submits a letter to the Hiawatha Seaway Council advising them of the circumstances of the withdrawal from the 2010 National Jamboree contingent.
- The parent or guardian of the jamboree Scout participant will be provided with two copies of this policy. Both will need to be signed and dated and returned to the Hiawatha Seaway Council no later than 10 days after the date this policy is mailed to you. The address is: 2803 Brewerton Road Mattydale, NY 13211. Both copies will be signed by a representative of the Council Jamboree Committee and one will be returned to you.
